The troop meeting commands address Scouts and leaders who are familiar with the troop procedures. Therefore, it is not necessary to instruct them on what to do if not in uniform. For this ceremony, troop members are usually standing so it is not necessary to ask them to rise.

The Court of Honor commands acknowledge that this is a public gathering and there may be guests present who are not in Scout uniform. For this ceremony, the audience is usually seated and is asked to rise.
