Troop 202 Code of Conduct

I commit to live by the Scout Oath and Law while participating in all events with Troop 202.

SCOUT OATH: On my honor, I will do my best

To do my duty to God and my country and to obey the Scout Law;

To help other people at all times;

To keep myself physically strong, mentally awake, and morally straight.

SCOUT LAW: A Scout is Trustworthy, Loyal, Helpful, Friendly, Courteous, Kind, Obedient, Cheerful, Thrifty, Brave, Clean, and Reverent.

Some EXAMPLES of how I will behave are listed below.

- ____ I will be kind and respectful to all.
- ____ I will be obedient and cheerful in following the direction of my leaders.
- ____ I will listen courteously when asked to participate in coaching, discussion, or problem solving.
- ____ I will not use foul or abusive language.
- ____ I will not leave areas where my Troop is gathered except with permission and with a buddy.
- ____ I will participate cheerfully and constructively in the planned activities.
- ____ I will be helpful in setting up and cleaning my work and camping areas, and helping others with theirs.
- ____ I will care for Troop equipment, using and maintaining it properly.
- ____ I will respect the property of other Scouts and will not use it without their permission.
- ____ I will set a positive example for other Scouts.
- ____ I will do my best in competition and be gracious in both victory and defeat.
- ____ I will represent Troop 202 in a positive light at all times through my behavior and attitude.
- ____ I will make group needs a priority over my own preferences.
- ____ I will make any disagreements or issues known in a constructive way.

This applies to my behavior at Troop meetings, service projects, Color Guard activities, camping trips, and any other Troop 202 activities and outings.

If, at any time during a Troop activity, I am not behaving according to this commitment, my parent agrees that he/she will come to the location of the activity and remove me. Each time I attend a Troop outing, my parent will make this commitment before departure and note it in writing on my permission form. In the event that it is necessary for my parent to pick me up from an activity due to behavior problems, I will not be allowed to attend future Troop activities without my parent accompanying me throughout the event. If behavior problems persist despite my parent's attendance, I may be asked to reconsider whether I am committed to living by the Scout Oath and Law and participating as a member of Troop 202.
