

## PACKING FOR SUMMER CAMP

### CHECK-IN & TRAVEL

*Do not put these items in your bin, foot locker, or duffel. You must show them at check-in, and you'll need access to them at camp before the trailer is unpacked. Use a day pack or cinch bag.*

- bagged lunch (to eat when we arrive at camp)
- medications – must be in original pharmacy container
- rain gear (at least a jacket or heavy duty poncho)
- durable/refillable *full* water bottle
- wear your Class A uniform shirt
- wear closed-toe shoes
- swim trunks & towel, if you need a swim test at camp
- forms if needed for Ransburg X, ATV, or PWC
- health form A/B/C and insurance card - already in
- payment (registration, class fees, cash card) - already in

### DAILY CAMP CLOTHES

- shorts for each day
- t-shirts (with BSA logo or no logo) for each day
- Class B troop t-shirt
- underwear for each day
- socks for each day
- closed-toe shoes or boots
- spare shoes
- sweater or jacket
- hat

### HEALTH & SAFETY

- insect repellent (non-aerosol), if desired  
(If high DEET content, a daily shower is required.)
- sunscreen (non-aerosol), if desired
- anti-chafing powder or ointment, if desired
- small personal first aid kit  
(Kit contains only items you may use, and you know how to use.)

### PRE-CAMP PREP TASKS

- work with patrol to select tent partners
- write home address in Scout Handbook (for postcard)
- complete prerequisite work
- set goals for advancement, experiences, achievements

### DO NOT PACK

- cell phones or other electronics
- chair (unless an Eagle Scout or adult)
- woods tools such as hatchets or axes
- straight knife or spring-opening knife
- knife longer than your hand when it is open
- food of any kind in your tent

### GEAR STORAGE

- bin, foot locker, or waterproof duffel
- plastic bag to keep clean clothes dry
- piece of paracord for a clothesline
- plastic bag for wet items packed for return home

### TOILET/SHOWER

- soap or body wash
- shampoo
- towel
- toothbrush & toothpaste
- comb
- flip-flops or other shower shoes, if desired

### SLEEPING

- sleeping bag (no pad needed since cots are provided)
- top sheet or blanket, if desired
- hammock, if desired
- small pillow (or pillowcase to stuff with other items)
- mesh bug net, if desired
- sleeping clothes

### SCOUT TOOLS

- flashlight or headlamp
- Scout Handbook
- Troop 202 song book
- Totin' Chip (to use knife or woods tools)
- Firem'n Chit (to use matches)
- Cyber Chip (if taking Photography merit badge)
- pen/pencil
- wristwatch
- folding pocket knife
- small amount of duct tape for minor repairs
- matches
- prerequisite work, if any, for classes
- partial merit badge blue cards from the past, if desired
- playing cards, if desired
- hammock (and straps/ties), if desired
- small snacks, if desired, in sealed plastic container  
(Food items of any kind must be stored in the trailer overnight.)

### ITEMS ALLOWED for ADULT CAMPERS

- personal tent
- camp chair
- backpacking stove or jetboil for coffee/tea
- coffee mug
- cell phone

**LABEL EVERYTHING!!**

**ITEMS NEEDED for INDIVIDUAL CLASSES or ACTIVITIES**

**SPECIAL ITEMS for AQUATICS**

- swim trunks with gear if not taking swim test on arrival)
- towel
- swim goggles, if desired

**SPECIAL ITEMS for SHOOTING SPORTS**

- fully enclosed shoes required

**SPECIAL ITEMS for HORSEBACK RIDING**

- long pants required
- shoes or boots with a heel are recommended

**SPECIAL ITEMS for PHOTOGRAPHY MERIT BADGE**

- Cyber Chip card
- digital camera or cell phone, if desired  
(Camera or phone is store by the Scoutmaster between classes.)

**SPECIAL ITEMS for PERSONAL WATERCRAFT**

- IN Boater Education course completion certificate
- photo ID
- signed PWC waiver form

**SPECIAL ITEMS for FIRECRAFTER**

If you are a youth Firecrafter (3<sup>rd</sup> rank) and plan to help in the Firecrafter area or grade campfires:

- Firecrafter fire shirt and undershirt
- BSA Scout pants

**SPECIAL ITEMS for C.O.P.E.**

- long pants, if desired

**SPECIAL ITEMS for RANSBURG X**

- signed Marengo Cave permission form
- signed ATV waiver form
- signed ASI COVID-19 Liability Waiver form
- ATV ASI online training completion certificate
- long jean pants required
- sturdy ankle-height boots required
- long sleeve t-shirt required
- your sleeping gear and aquatics wear for some days

**SPECIAL ITEMS for ATV CLASS**

- signed ATV waiver form
- signed ASI COVID-19 Liability Waiver form
- ATV ASI online training completion certificate
- long jean pants required
- sturdy ankle-height boots
- long sleeve t-shirt required

**SPECIAL ITEMS for WELDING MERIT BADGE**

- leather boots required
- long pants required

**SPECIAL ITEMS for ORDER OF THE ARROW**

If you are an Arrowman and plan to participate in fellowship, sash night (at dinner), or Brotherhood:

- OA sash
- Brotherhood review materials, if needed
