- Key Tasks:
- Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
 - Be registered in a Scouting America adult position.
 - Complete and maintain position-specific training, if any, for the registered Scouting America position.
 - Provide advice and feedback as requested by a Scout planning and executing a conservation-related service project. Projects might be individual or troop service activities, work toward a merit badge requirement, work in partial completion of a Scouting America conservation award, or an Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project.
 - Help Scouts understand what is “good science” when planning and executing conservation projects. This includes using evidence-based methods to identify threats to the environment and applying cost-effective interventions that contribute to long-term positive outcomes.
 - Ensure that safety protocols are understood and addressed in the project planning.
 - Maintain liaisons with outside groups that promote conservation, e.g., Department of Natural Resources, parks, educational organizations, civic groups, etc.
