- Key Tasks:
- Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
 - Complete position-specific training for the Merit Badge Counselor role.
 - Become familiar with current requirements and resources from Scouting America for the merit badge(s) you are registered to counsel.
 - Work with Scouts as requested on merit badges for which the counselor is approved by the council.
 - Sign off on merit badge requirements, being loyal to the requirements as written by Scouting America, not adding or subtracting from what a Scout must do to earn the badge.
 - Avoid counseling your own son or close relative on a merit badge unless he is part of a group working together on the badge.
