Position: Mentor to Color Guard Commander

Incumbent: Mr. Heath

- Key Tasks:
- Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
  - Serve as a mentor and positive role model to the youth in the Color Guard Commander role.
  - Advise the Color Guard Commander on correct protocol for displaying and parading the U.S. flag, troop flag, and other flags.
  - Meet with the Color Guard Commander to set appropriate goals for the leadership term consistent with the youth job description and the troop's needs.
  - Help any new Color Guard Commander to learn the correct commands for troop meeting opening and closing. Provide constructive correction and feedback when the commands and protocol for parading flags are not followed with due attention and respect.
  - Chaperone the Color Guard Commander at outside events as necessary, including securing the participation of a second registered adult to satisfy two-deep leadership requirements.
  - Assist the Color Guard Commander as needed in maintaining the U.S. and troop flags in good and presentable condition, including flags, stands, and harnesses.
