Position: Mentor to Instructor

Incumbent: Mentors are activated during a leadership term where a youth leader is assigned to the topic. Examples:

Camp Cooking – Mr. McDonald
First Aid – Mr. Dowell
Fitness – Mr. Wasik
Games – Mr. Rozmaryn
Knots & Lashings – (open)
Map & Compass – (open)
S.T.E.M. – Mr. Considine
Water Safety – Mr. Dowell

- Key Tasks:
- Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
 - Serve as a mentor and positive role model to the youth in a troop Instructor role.
 - Meet with the assigned Instructor to set appropriate goals for the leadership term consistent with the youth job description and the troop's needs.
 - Encourage the Instructor to increase his knowledge of the assigned subject and to gather materials to enrich his teaching in the troop.
 - Coach the Instructor to be a resource to Scouts on a regular basis related to the assigned topic, not just when making a presentation to the troop.
