Position: Mentor to Quartermaster of Tools & Fire

- Key Tasks:
- Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
 - Serve as a mentor and positive role model to the youth in the Quartermaster of Tools & Fire role.
 - Meet with the Quartermaster of Tools & Fire to develop goals for the leadership term, consistent with their job description and the troop's needs. Consult with the lead Mentor to the Quartermaster team to ensure alignment of goals and priorities.
 - Become an expert on the troop's woods tools, fire making/tending equipment (fire pans, matches, buckets, etc.), and rope. Know where each item is stored, how to use it, how to maintain it, and how to repair it.
 - Know the principles of Leave No Trace, including when and where it is appropriate to build a campfire, how to properly tend a fire, and how to put a fire out cold.
 - Coach the Quartermaster of Tools & Fire in keeping all woods tools sharpened, safely sheathed, and properly stored.
 - Know how to set up an axe yard and enforce its safe use. Help the Quartermaster of Tools & Fire maintain an axe yard kit, including synthetic rope and signs, in the storage box labeled for this use.
 - Help coach the Quartermaster team on establishing, communicating, and using effective methods for gear issue and return.
 - Help coach Scouts on safe and correct care and use of gear.
