### Adult Position – Mentor to Quartermaster

Position: Mentor to Quartermaster

Incumbent: Mr. Pyatt

- Key Tasks:
- Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
  - Serve as a mentor and positive role model to the youth in the Quartermaster role.
  - Meet with the youth Quartermaster team to develop goals for their leadership term, consistent with their job descriptions and the troop's needs.
  - Work with the Quartermaster to maintain a multi-year plan for gear replacement.
  - Recommend gear repairs or replacements based on the troop's goals and available funds.
  - Guide the Quartermaster in maintaining an itemized inventory of all gear, including specifications and replacement value.
  - Coach the Quartermaster team on establishing, communicating, and using effective methods for gear issue and return.
  - Coach Scouts on safe and correct care and use of gear.
  - Ensure legal and insurance requirements for gear and vehicles are met.
  - Help train adults to earn their Towin' Chip for the large and/or small trailers.
  - Advise Quartermaster team on pulling gear to meet the needs of upcoming outings.
  - Work with adults who are assigned to mentor each assistant Quartermaster on a portion of the troop gear. Help them understand how the gear works and is cared for.
