- Key Tasks:
- Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
 - Achieve and maintain own membership in Order of the Arrow.
 - Serve as a mentor and positive role model to the troop Order of the Arrow Representative, helping him to build an effective bridge between the unit and the Chapter (district) and Lodge (council).
 - Meet with the Order of the Arrow Representative to set appropriate goals for the leadership term that are consistent with the youth job description and troop needs.
 - Help the Order of the Arrow Representative make at least one presentation per year to promote participation in weekend campouts.
 - Promote incorporation of Order of the Arrow ideals of fellowship, cheerfulness, and service into the troop's program and advancement process.
 - Encourage Order of the Arrow members participation in Chapter events.
 - Attend Chapter meetings when possible and encourage youth attendance.
 - Assist the Order of the Arrow Representative with hosting the annual Order of the Arrow unit election, including ensuring adequate attendance to allow an election to be held.
 - Gather youth Order of the Arrow members to rehearse and present ceremonies as requested at pack Crossover and Arrow of Light events.
