- Key Tasks:
- Complete all basic and position-specific training before registering.
 - Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
 - Complete and maintain current Weather Hazards training.
 - Participate actively in troop meetings and outings.
 - Serve as a role model to all youth in the troop.
 - Coach and mentor the Patrol Leader of the assigned patrol. Meet with him to set appropriate goals for the leadership term, consistent with the job description and the troop's needs.
 - Reinforce use of the Patrol Method, helping Scouts understand it is the basic and essential structure of a troop. Instruct Scouts on how to use patrol work processes like duty rosters, Grubmaster menus, tent partners, etc.
 - Provide guidance to the patrol's Grubmaster for each outing, approving the menu, explaining the budget, and identifying gear needs.
 - Help direct Scouts in the patrol to appropriate youth resources within the troop for answers to their questions.
 - With the Patrol Leader, monitor morale and performance of the patrol. Monitor attendance and participation by individual patrol members. Alert the Scoutmaster if retention of a Scout in the patrol is at risk and recommend actions to address concerns.
 - Encourage the patrol to earn the National Honor Patrol award.
 - Assist the Scoutmaster by providing direct supervision and mentoring to the assigned patrol. Take turns with other Patrol Advisors and registered adults supervising assigned troop meetings to deliver an effective and engaging troop program.
