- Key Tasks:
- Complete all basic and position-specific training before registering.
 - Complete and maintain current Safeguarding Youth training and Diocese Protocol training.
 - Complete and maintain current Weather Hazards training.
 - Participate actively in troop meetings and outings.
 - Serve as a positive role model to all Scouts in the troop.
 - Mentor all Scouts in the troop in personal growth, leadership, and advancement.
 - Recruit and delegate to Patrol Advisors and Assistant Scoutmasters as appropriate to assist in ensuring a safe, effective, engaging, and positive troop experience for all Scouts.
 - Reinforce the Patrol Method, helping Scouts understand it is the basic and essential structure of a troop.
 - Coach the Senior Patrol Leader in planning and running an effective and engaging troop program.
 - Coach the Patrol Leaders' Council to plan effective and engaging troop meetings and activities.
 - Ensure adequate adult supervision and mentoring is on hand to execute an effective and engaging troop program at meetings, activities, and outings.
 - Conduct Scoutmaster conferences for rank advancement or as requested by Scouts.
