



Troop 202 Annual Planning Process

Step 1 Submit Outing Ideas

Before the **August PLC**, Scouts and adults submit ideas for outings. There's a link on the troop website.

Step 2 Narrow Down Ideas

At the **August PLC** meeting, the PLC narrows down the list to 8 to 10 ideas, and assigns them to patrols or individuals to research.

Step 3 Research the Ideas

The assigned patrol or person researches the activity, location, and cost and makes a poster to pitch it at the planning meeting.

Step 4 Sign Up!

Sign up to attend the August **Family Cookout & Annual Planning Meeting**.

Step 5 Annual Planning Meeting

1. Present the outing ideas.
2. Choose the best ones.
3. Put outings on the troop calendar.
4. Assign the adult & youth planners.
