

# PATROL

**POSITIONS IN RED MUST BE FILLED FOR EACH PATROL.**

<p><b>PATROL LEADER</b>          assigns jobs in the patrol, represents patrol at PLC meetings and reports back, leads patrol meetings, helps patrol members meet goals, and leads work for getting patrol awards</p>	
<p><b>ASSISTANT PATROL LEADER</b>          assists the patrol leader, and does the patrol leader's job if he isn't there</p>	

**USE OTHER POSITIONS AS NEEDED SO EACH PATROL MEMBER IS ASSIGNED ONLY ONE ROLE.**

<p><b>PATROL QUARTERMASTER</b>          helps teach patrol members how to use troop gear properly; keeps track of any patrol equipment between outings and supervises the cleaning and storage of equipment after outings</p>	
<p><b>PATROL CHAPLAIN AIDE</b>          takes notes in patrol meetings and writes down attendance at each troop and patrol meeting</p>	
<p><b>SERVICE SPECIALIST</b>          helps patrol members be aware of service projects that can be done together or on our own, keeps track of the patrol's group service work</p>	
<p><b>PATROL SPIRIT SPECIALIST</b>          in charge of the patrol flag and brings it to all troop outings; teaches the patrol yell to new members, keeps track of patrol souvenirs and trophies</p>	
<p><b>UNIFORM INSPECTION SPECIALIST</b>          makes sure everyone in the patrol has the right uniform and knows how to wear it, and that the patrol is ready for troop uniform inspections</p>	
<p><b>ADVANCEMENTS SPECIALIST</b>          keeps track of what rank each member of the patrol is, so that members can help each other advance; sees what merit badges people would like to work on together</p>	
<p><b>KNOTS &amp; LASHINGS SPECIALIST</b>          takes a special interest in knots and lashings; hones his own skills in this area, and helps patrol members improve skills</p>	
<p><b>ORIENTEERING SPECIALIST</b>          takes a special interest in map and compass work; hones his own skills in this area, and helps patrol members improve skills</p>	
<p><b>FIRST AID SPECIALIST</b>          takes a special interest in first aid; hones his own skills in this area, and helps patrol members improve skills</p>	

**SOME ROLES ARE NOT FILLED FOR THE WHOLE TERM, BUT FOR EACH ACTIVITY OR OUTING.**

<p><b>GRUBMASTER</b>          writes down the menu and recipes for the outing, makes a shopping list, gets the food and stores it so it won't spoil, stays within the food budget for the trip</p>	<p>-----</p>
