



## Instructor

- Description:** Appointed by the Senior Patrol Leader to serve as a resource for teaching a Scout skill, either by providing the knowledge or by arranging to bring in an expert
- Reports To:** ASPL of Communication & Skills
- Eligibility:** First Class rank or higher, unless special approval is given by the Scoutmaster
- Duties:** Instruct members of the troop in the assigned skill area.
- Look for opportunities to incorporate skills in your subject area into troop meetings and outings. Work with the PLC to plan meeting activities and arrange for needed materials or outside resources.
- Proactively work with the Troop Guides and Patrol Leaders to set up learning opportunities for young Scouts to work on skills needed for advancement. Recruit additional help when needed.
- If appropriate, create new resources for the troop library to support learning in the skill area assigned to you.

- First Aid
  - Knots & Lashings
  - Map & Compass
  - Fitness
  - Hiking & Backpacking
  - Camp Cooking
