



Outdoor Ethics Guide

Description: Appointed by the Senior Patrol Leader to help the troop plan and conduct an outdoor program that emphasizes effectively practicing the Outdoor Code, the Leave No Trace principles, and the Tread Lightly! Principles.

Reports To: ASPL of Gear & Outings

Eligibility: First Class rank or higher, unless special approval is given by the Scoutmaster

Duties: Work with Scouts in the troop to improve their outdoor ethics decision-making skills to help minimize impacts as they hike, camp, and participate in outdoor activities.

Support Scouts who are working to complete Outdoor Ethics related requirements for Tenderfoot, Second Class, and First Class ranks.

Encourage work on conservation-related projects, including those that support rank advancement requirements or conservation awards.

Complete a Leave No Trace awareness course either in person or online.

Complete a Tread Lightly! awareness course either in person or online.
